



# Roadworks are starting in your area soon

## What's happening, where and when?

**What:** Highway improvement works. We will be undertaking essential maintenance on the bridge over the railway. The works will involve removing the existing carriageway and verges to expose the bridge deck to apply a new waterproof coating. Once the waterproof coating has been installed the carriageway and verges will be re-instated. These works will be undertaken to improve the longevity of the structure.

**Where:** A6 Desborough at the location of the railway bridge, between Braybrooke Road, roundabout and Desborough Road roundabout.

**When:** The road will be closed from Friday 9<sup>th</sup> of June at 20:00 to Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> of June at 06:00.

**How long:** 4 days

**Traffic Management:** Full weekend and a day and night closure. There will be a diversion route in place during the closure. The **red** line below shows the works area, and the **blue** line below shows the diversion route.

**Emergency Vehicles:** will be required to follow the diversion.

**Access and Egress, Residents and Through Traffic:** There are no properties within the closure that will be affected. Through traffic will be required to follow the diversion.

**Public Transport:** Will not be affected.

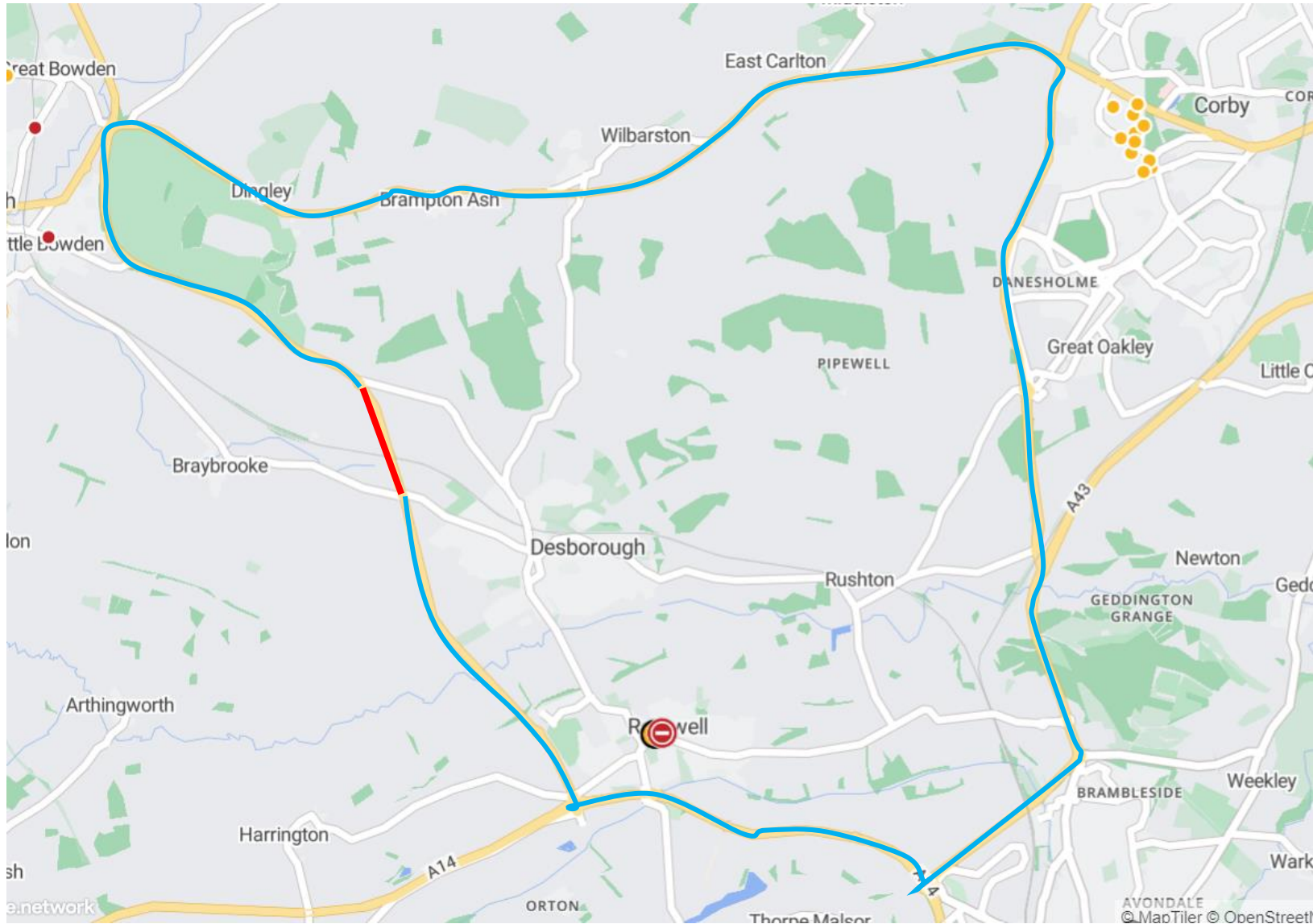
