

Roadworks are starting in your area soon. **What's happening, where and when?**

What: Installation of one-way system

Where: Gladstone Street, Desborough

When: Monday 15th January – Tuesday 30th January (weekday working only)

How long: 10 days (08:00am – 16:00pm)

Traffic Management: There will be a 24/7 road closure on Gladstone Street, Desborough. With no access for through traffic, access for residents only. A diversion will be installed as shown on the map adjacent. The **red** line shows the road closure extents, and the **blue** line shows the diversion route.

Emergency Vehicles: No through route for emergency vehicles. Emergency access to residents will be maintained.

Residents/Businesses: The closure will be installed from Gladstone Street roundabout to junction with Nichols Street during the day. Overnight the closure will be reduced to allow access for residents. Access for residents and businesses will be maintained, with a turning area to be put in place halfway up Gladstone Street. This will be symbolised with no parking cones. Where possible please use the Co-op car park for parking.

Public Transport: There will be no bus service during the working hours.

Parking: To help us with our work, please move any vehicles parked between the roundabout and House 6. This is to enable our workforce to be able to carry out the works swiftly, without delay. We also ask that you park leaving a minimum of 20 metres of any junction for the duration of the works. Advanced 'No Parking' warning signs will be placed in the area 24 hours before. Thank you for your understanding, patience, and co-operation.





Parking and Property/Business Access

We will assist residents and business owners accessing and egressing their buildings. We also recommend you plan extra time for your journeys.

We hope this information is helpful and we apologise for any inconvenience these essential works may cause. We will make every effort to minimise any unnecessary disruption. Our team on site will be ready to assist you with any issues you may have during the work and we hope you will find our employees courteous and helpful.
